

TUITION AND FEES

Full-time Students: Tuition for the Fall 2011 semester is \$13,125.00 (plus a \$300 registration and general service fee) for full-time students. Therefore, the minimum amount due by June 27, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. is \$6,563.00, as you have already paid a \$300 seat deposit which will now be applied to your fees.

Part-time Students: Tuition for the Fall 2011 semester is \$8,750.00 (plus a \$300 registration and general service fee) for part-time students. Therefore, the minimum amount due by June 27, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. is \$4,375.00, as you have already paid a \$300 seat deposit which will now be applied to your fees.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

If you are receiving financial aid:

- You must accept aid in the form of Stafford loans, TEG grants or institutional scholarships totaling at least 50% of tuition plus fees by June 27, 2011. Graduate Plus Loans do not qualify for this provision.
- You can access your financial aid award to determine if you meet the 50% tuition plus fees criteria above by clicking on the Campus Life tab, Student Quick Links channel, Academic Services link. If you do not have Stafford loans, TEG grants or institutional scholarships totaling the amount above for your enrollment status you are required to pay any shortfall to Accounting Services by the above date.

If you are NOT receiving financial aid:

- You will be required to pay your tuition in full or elect the Deferred Payment Option (requires payment of 50% of tuition by June 27, 2011). You **may** elect the Deferred Payment Option by submitting the [Deferred Payment Request Form](#) to Accounting Services before the above deadline.

Your account balance is available online via STANLEY. Go to the Campus Life tab and select Academic Services from the Student Quick Links, then select Student and Financial Aid, then Student Account. To pay by electronic check, choose the Pay by Check link at the bottom of the Account pages.

The amount of qualified aid you have accepted is located on the Account Detail for Term page on the Student Account menu. You are required to pay any shortfall by the above deadline.

Important Note: No bills are sent prior to the payment deadline. Account information **may be accessed online via STANLEY. Students are responsible for compliance with payment deadlines.**

All payments must be made directly to the Accounting Services Office.
