2009-2010 Academic Year and 2010 Summer Session

During the academic year, tuition is set depending on your status as a full-time or part-time student; during the summer session tuition is determined based on the number of hours taken. The full payment of tuition and fees is due by the published due date unless the deferred tuition payment program is elected. Details of this program are described below:

DEFERRED TUITION PAYMENT PROGRAM

1. The election to utilize the deferred payment program is available **ONLY** at registration.
2. 50% of tuition, a \$300 mandatory **NON-REFUNDABLE** Registration and General Services Fee, and a \$25 **NON-REFUNDABLE** Deferred Tuition Fee, must be paid by the published due date. Financial Aid recipients will be deemed to have met this requirement if they have **accepted** aid in the form of Stafford Loans, TEG, or institutional scholarships in amounts sufficient to meet the above requirements. Any shortfall must be paid in full. Grad Plus loans do not qualify for this provision.
3. **No bills will be sent prior to the payment deadline.** You may access your account information online via STANLEY. (**SEE THE TUITION AND FEES AND THE DEFERRED PAYMENTS SCHEDULES FOR REQUIRED PAYMENT AMOUNTS AND DUE DATES.**)
4. Failure to make the required payments will result in the denial of this payment option for any future enrollment period. In addition, failure to make the required payments may result in exclusion from classes and will result in a hold being placed on your account until payment is received.

NOTE 1: Students must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours during the fall and spring semesters and at least 3 credit hours in the 8-week summer session to be eligible for financial aid.

NOTE 2: If your Financial Aid does not fully cover your tuition and fees, you must, at the time your financial aid is disbursed, either pay the shortfall in full or elect to pay the \$25 NON-REFUNDABLE Deferred Tuition Fee to utilize the deferred payment program with respect to the shortfall.

\$25.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR EACH RETURNED CHECK. IF A CHECK GIVEN TO SOUTH TEXAS FOR REGISTRATION IS RETURNED FOR ANY REASON, OTHER THAN STOP PAYMENT, REGISTRATION WILL BE CANCELLED. The student may then register for any open classes on the date of late registration and be subject to the \$40.00 late registration fee.
