(Problem Release, Designation of Roles to be Played by Teams, Trial Brief Deadline Unchanged, Clarification Request Deadline Changed, Official Ballot)

The tournament problem is being sent to you by email today and will be posted to the website tomorrow.

South Texas students will play the roles of Pat Byers and Sam Stevens. Team members will play the roles of Louis Keating or Louise Keating and Dr. Walter Wallace or Dr. Zoe Brockette. Teams representing the Plaintiffs must call either Louis Keating or Louise Keating live. They may call the other by deposition. Teams representing the Defendants must call either Walter Wallace or Zoe Brockette live. They may call the other by deposition. The depositions of these witnesses are written so Louis and Louise may testify about information contained in the other's deposition. The same is true of Dr. Wallace and Dr. Brockette. *See* Local Rules.

The delay in the release of the problem will not affect the deadline for trial briefs, which are due Friday, March 3rd. Teams received all necessary information (other than the style of the case which is contained in the problem) in Bulletin 2, which was released February 13th.

The deadline for clarification requests will be Friday, March 10th.
