

**Ruth Hargrove**, Professor of Legal Writing at California Western School of Law, received her B.A., *magna cum laude* from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst and her J.D. *cum laude*, from the University of San Diego. Before she joined the California Western faculty, she spent seven years as a prosecutor in California where she was instrumental in starting the Domestic Violence Unit that served as a model for other prosecution agencies in the state. She was Assistant in-house counsel for a city, handling litigation and representing the City's boards and departments for ten years. In her pro bono practice, Professor Hargrove has represented high school students in discipline proceedings and tenants in proceedings against landlords.
