

The Susan Scoble Scholarship Award For Student Workers

The Susan Scoble Scholarship Award was established in 2011 to honor Susan June Scoble, Patron Services Librarian at South Texas College of Law Houston, who had a unique way of connecting with and helping others and was especially important to a multitude of student workers who lovingly called her their "library mom." Her compassion and words of encouragement inspired them to be strong during tough times and push through struggles with determination.

The award is presented at the end of each semester to a student who is employed at South Texas College of Law Houston in the work-study program at the time of application. All student workers are eligible to apply.

The completed application form must be accompanied by the following:

- A. A double-spaced typed statement of up to 500 words describing: (1) your experiences working at STCL, (2) how the working experience is helping your personal growth, (3) situations in which you went beyond the call of duty to assist other students, and (4) circumstances when you, like Susan, put others' needs before your own.
- B. A current résumé.
