The world has changed dramatically since we last held in-person classes on campus in March!

As we prepare to return to in-person classes tomorrow – and to protect the health and safety of our community and to ensure that we can keep campus open – please note the following:

- 1. Everyone who has a smartphone faculty, staff, and students must use the ReturnSafe app to gain admittance to the building. Please see the <u>Downloading</u> information and Instructions for use.
- 2. Always err on the side of community safety: <u>When in doubt, stay home</u>. Any student can access any class remotely.
- 3. <u>Please allow extra time to get into the building and to get to classes</u>. It will take a bit longer to get through security, and elevator access is limited to four persons at a time in the Tower and two at a time in the Library.
- 4. Everyone must be completely candid when answering ReturnSafe screening questions; gaining access to campus through inaccurate responses may be considered an honor violation.
- 5. All students even those with online-only classes may come to campus when campus is open, may use the library and other study spaces, and may access school resources.
- 6. Everyone must wear a mask, follow safe distancing rules, avoid congregating in groups, and comply with movement control practices whenever on campus; please also use hand sanitizer regularly and sit only in designated spaces while attending on-campus classes.
- 7. We have set aside designated classrooms to access Zoom classes so that any student (including students who have both in-person and online classes) can participate in online classes while on campus. See the Registrar's FAQs for the specific locations.
- 8. We are all in this together. Please correct and report any violations of the safety protocols; the stakes are too high to tolerate lapses.
- 9. Failure to comply with safety protocols may result in various sanctions, including immediate revocation of campus-access privileges.
