

## Policy on actions regarding potential or suspected COVID-19 scenarios

Please see guidelines below, based on individual situations regarding COVID-19.

- 1. I have tested positive for COVID-19, with symptoms**
  - a. Stay home
  - b. Report all cases of suspected COVID-19 exposure or infection — as soon as two or more COVID-19 symptoms appear — through the ReturnSafe app.
  - c. Return to the law school after
    - i. 14 days since symptoms first appears AND
    - ii. 24 hours without a fever (without using any fever-reducing medications) AND
    - iii. **You no longer have any COVID-19 symptoms or have been cleared by a doctor to return to school.**
  
- 2. I have tested positive for COVID-19, but without any symptoms**
  - a. Stay home
  - b. Report all cases of suspected COVID-19 exposure or infection — as soon as two or more COVID-19 symptoms appear — through the ReturnSafe app.
  - c. Return to law school after 14 days have passed since you had a positive viral test for COVID-19, unless otherwise directed by your physician.
  
- 3. I have multiple COVID-19 symptoms, but have either not been tested, have not received my test results, or tested negative for COVID-19**
  - a. Stay home
  - b. Report all cases of suspected COVID-19 exposure or infection — as soon as two or more COVID-19 symptoms appear — through the ReturnSafe app.
  - c. Return to law school after
    - i. 14 days since symptoms first appears AND
    - ii. 24 hours without a fever (without using any fever-reducing medications) AND
    - iii. symptoms you no longer have COVID symptoms or have been cleared by a doctor to return to school.
  
- 4. I have a fever of more than 100.4F, but no other symptoms**
  - a. Stay home
  - b. Return to law school after 24 hours without a fever (without using any fever-reducing medications), provided that you are not experiencing any other COVID-19 symptoms. If you are, see # 3.
  
- 5. I have no symptoms, but have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19**
  - a. Stay home
  - b. Report all cases of suspected COVID-19 exposure or infection — as soon as two or more COVID-19 symptoms appear — through the ReturnSafe app.

- c. Return to law school after 14 days following your last exposure
- 6. I have no symptoms, but have been in close contact with someone who has multiple COVID-19 symptoms**
- a. Same as #5
- 7. I have no symptoms, but have been in close contact with someone who may have been exposed to the coronavirus**
- a. Same as #5
- 8. I have no symptoms and have been tested, but I am still waiting for my results**
- a. Return to law school after 14 days following your last exposure, provided that you do not have any COVID symptoms.
  - b. Report all cases of suspected COVID-19 exposure or infection — as soon as two or more COVID-19 symptoms appear — through the ReturnSafe app.
