

CARES ACT INFORMATION

MONTHLY REPORTING UNDER 188004(e)

1. South Texas College of Law Houston (STCLH) signed and returned to the DOE the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
2. STCLH received a total of \$261,251.00 from the DOE pursuant to our Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. A total of \$261,251.00 was distributed to students as of the date of the report.
4. An estimated total of 693 students at the law school were eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 of Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965.
5. A total of 693 students received a grant under Section 18004(a)(1).
6. In accordance with Section 18004(a)(1) the law school determined eligibility for Cares Act awards based on a student's FAFSA completion and eligibility for federal student aid.
7. Eligible students were notified of their CARES Act award at the time of disbursement.
