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A couple minor edits to the problem. I have included a document showing the four changes and an updated problem.

One more clarification:

- The South Texas student you were assigned on Friday will play one of the two witness roles when your team argues as the Plaintiffs side and one of the two witness roles when your team argues the Defense side. Each team is assigned one South Texas student to play the two roles.


