South Texas College of Law Houston is one of only three schools nationwide consistently ranked in the top 10 for trial advocacy by U.S. News & World Report. South Texas has won 136 national advocacy championships, twice as many as any other law school.

South Texas College of Law Houston has won five first-place Best Brief awards in the American Society of Legal Writers’ Scribes competition — the most prestigious legal writing competition in the nation. No other law school has claimed this honor more than once.

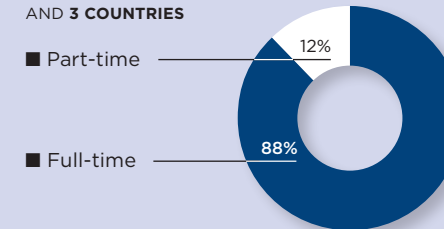

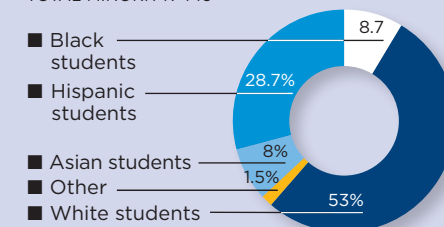
## STUDENTS: 2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

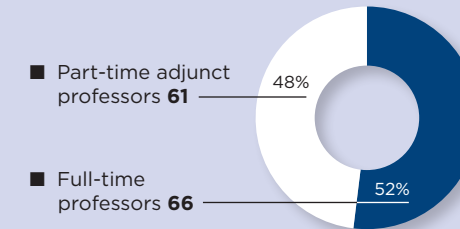
## J.D. ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY
