

VETERANS BENEFIT CERTIFICATION

Effective August 1, 2024 to July 31, 2025, the Post-9/11 GI Bill® will pay up to \$28,937.09 for private school tuition and mandatory fees. You must contact VA to complete and submit the application form available online. You will receive written notification explaining VA's decision regarding your eligibility for the program. If you are eligible, your Certificate of Eligibility will also advise you if your service meets the requirements for the Yellow Ribbon Program.

In order to be certified for VA benefits, you must submit the following documents to the Office of Student Services (Suite 267):

1. **DD-214.** Your DD-214 can be obtained by going to:

2. **Certificate of Eligibility**
3. **Military Transcripts.** Information about Military Transcripts for any branch of the military and how to request them is available at the following link: <https://jst.doded.mil>. 4. **Transcripts from all post-secondary schools** (anything above high school)
5. **[VA Benefit Certification Request](#)** form for each semester that you wish to be certified. If at any time your enrollment status changes, you must submit a **[VA Benefit Certification - Change Request](#)** form so your VA certification can be amended.
6. **[Veteran Benefit Yellow Ribbon Request](#)** form if you are eligible for the program. Submit prior to the academic year for which you are requesting the Yellow Ribbon Program.
